The following information from the Registry of the International Court of Justice has been communicated to the Press:

The International Court of Justice held a public sitting to-day,
April 12th, 1951, in the case concerning Reservations to the Convention
on Genocide.

Mr. Rosenne, representative of Israel, continued and concluded his statement.

To-morrow a statement will be presented on behalf of the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland by the Attorney-General, Sir Hartley Shawcross.
