The following information, emanating from the Registry of the International Court of Justice, has been communicated to the Press:

In the Haya de la Torre case, now before the International Court of Justice, the Governments of Colombia and Peru have chosen as judges ad hoc:

For Colombia: M. José Joaquin Caicedo Castilla,

For Peru : M. Luis Alayza y Paz Soldan.

MM. Alayza and Caicedo had already acted as Judges ad hoc in the Asylum Case between the same States.

In addition, Colombia has appointed as its Agent M. J.G. de la Vega, Minister of Colombia to the Netherlands and as Counsel M. Camilo de Brigard and Professor J. Yepes.

Peru has appointed M. C. Sayan Alvarez as Agent and as Counsel Professor G. Scelle and M. J. Lopez Olivan. In addition, the Peruvian delegation will include M. F. Tudela, Advocate, M. Morales, Parliamentary Interpreter, and M. J.J. Calle y Calle, Secretary.

Colombia deposited its Memorial within the time-limit fixed, i.e. February 7th. The time-limit for the filing of the Counter-Memorial by Peru is March 15th, 1951.
