The following information has been unofficially communicated to the Press by the Registry of the International Court of Justice.

On March 13th, 1951, the Chargé d'Affaires of Cuba at The Hague transmitted to the Registrar of the International Court of Justice a communication dated Havana, February 15th, 1951, by which the Government of Cuba, referring to art. 63 of the Statute of the Court and referring to the Haya de la Torre Case (Colombia / Peru), stated to the Court its views on the interpretation of the Convention on Asylum, signed at Havana on February 20th, 1928.

Fursuant to article 66 of the Rules of Court, this communication will be notified to the parties concerned, and to the Members of the United Nations through the Secretary General and to other States entitled to appear before the Court.
