
Map of the Republic of Nicaragua compiled by Maximiliano Sonnestern by order of the Government, 1858






Physical-Geographical Map of the Republic of Nicaragua, Instituto Nicaragüense de Estudios Territoriales, Nicaragua, 2002,



NICARAGUA'S SOVEREINGTY OVER THE WHOLE COURSE OF THE SAN JUAN DE NICARAGUA RIVER




