

AFFIDAVIT

I, [REDACTED] of Monu Para, Buthidaung, Myanmar, currently residing in the refugee camps in Cox's Bazar, hereby declare that:

1. The statement I provided in 2020 in relation to the International Court of Justice (ICJ) case between The Gambia and Myanmar, and attached to this affidavit in its unredacted form, constitutes my full and complete testimony.
2. I confirm that the contents of this statement are correct and true to the best of my knowledge. I further wish to inform the Court that, in the five years since I submitted my statement, I have had an additional child – a daughter who is currently 2.5 years old, and that I now have five children in total. Additionally, I wish to clarify that in stating in the 2020 statement (¶7) that, in my capacity as a teacher in Myanmar, I was “paid 40,000 kyat” by the World Food Programme (WFP), I did not intend to convey that this was a cash salary paid to me, rather I received rice which I would sell in the market for at most 40,000 kyat and typically for a lesser amount.
3. I affirm that I am making this affidavit voluntarily, and I am aware that my unredacted statement will be submitted to the ICJ and will be shared with the Judges of the Court and the other Party, in accordance with the Court's order.
4. I am concerned about the security risks to which my family and I will be exposed as a result of our identities being disclosed to the other Party, given the reach of the Myanmar government within the camps in Bangladesh through operatives/informers who may threaten or harm us; this was the reason that I did not consent to disclosing my identity to the other Party in March 2023 upon request; Nevertheless, I remain confident in my decision to now disclose my identity to the other Party in pursuit of justice for my father, who was killed, and for our community.
5. I understand that I have been called to testify during the oral proceedings, and I agree to do so.
6. I understand that this affidavit and the attached unredacted statement and my testimony during the oral proceedings will remain confidential and will not be made public.
