Re: Case concerning Application of the Crime of Genocide on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide in Sudan (Sudan v. United Arab Emirates)

Excellency,

I have the honour, on behalf of the Republic of the Sudan (“Sudan”), to refer to paragraph 23 of Sudan’s Request for Provisional Measures dated 5 March 2025 in the case concerning Application of the Crime of Genocide on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide in Sudan (Sudan v. United Arab Emirates) (the “Request”).

Sudan wishes to modify the Order requested from the Court set out in paragraph 22 of its Request dated 5 March 2025. The amended Order that Sudan now respectfully requests, while maintaining all allegations set out in its Application and Request, is set out below:

“In view of the above, the Republic of the Sudan requests that, pending final judgment in this case, the Court indicate that:

(1) The United Arab Emirates shall, in accordance with its obligations under the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide, in relation to the Masalit group in the


Republic of the Sudan, take all measures within its power to prevent the commission of all acts within the scope of Article II of this Convention, in particular:

- (a) killing members of the group;
- (b) causing serious bodily or mental harm to the members of the group;
- (c) deliberately inflicting on the group conditions of life calculated to bring about its physical destruction in whole or in part; and
- (d) imposing measures intended to prevent births within the group.

(2) The United Arab Emirates shall, in accordance with its obligations under the Genocide Convention, in relation to the members of the Masalit group, refrain from any conduct amounting to complicity in the commission of any of the acts described in point (1) above by any irregular armed units, or by any organization or persons.

(3) The United Arab Emirates shall submit a report to the Court on all measures taken to give effect to this Order within one month, as from the date of this Order, and thereafter every six months, until a final decision on the case is rendered by the Court.”
