The following information from the Registry of the International Court of Justice has been communicated to the Press:

The International Court of Justice to-day (Friday, September 28th, 1951) held two sittings, during the course of which the oral proceedings in the Fisheries Case (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland v. Norway) were continued.

The Attorney-General, Sir Frank Soskice, K.C., continued his argument in support of the British case. He will again address the Court to-morrow (Saturday, September 29th) at the public hearing beginning at 10.30 a.m.
