READING OF THE JUDGMENT

The **PRESIDENT OF THE CHAMBER**: The Chamber meets today in order to deliver in open court, in accordance with Article 58 of the Statute and Article 94 of the Rules of Court, its Judgment on the Application of Nicaragua for permission to intervene in the case concerning the *Land, Island and Maritime Frontier Dispute (El Salvador/Honduras)*, brought before it by the notification of a Special Agreement between El Salvador and Honduras, signed in Esquipulas, Republic of Guatemala, on 24 May 1986.

The opening paragraphs of the Judgment, dealing with the procedural history of the case, will, as is customary, not be read out. I shall therefore start the reading at paragraph 22 of the Judgment.

I shall now ask the Registrar to read the operative clause of the Judgment in French.
