Elettronica Sicula S.p.A. (United States of America v. Italy)

Filing of Memorial

The following information is made available to the press by the Registry of the International Court of Justice:

On 15 May 1987, within the time-limit fixed by the Court in an Order of 2 March 1987, the United States filed the Memorial in the case concerning Elettronica Sicula S.p.A. which relates to a dispute between that country and Italy.

The time-limit for the filing of Italy's Counter-Memorial is 16 November 1987.

As previously announced, the case is to be dealt with by a Chamber which the Court, in an Order of 2 March 1987, constituted as follows: President Nagendra Singh (India); Judges Shigeru Oda (Japan), Roberto Ago (Italy), Stephen Schwebel (United States of America) and Sir Robert Jennings (United Kingdom).
