DEAR MR JENNINGS,

The Government of the Republic of Moldova thoroughly studied the Order of the International Court of Justice of 13 September 1993 concerning the WHO's request to the International Court of Justice to give an advisory opinion on the legality of the threat or use of nuclear weapons in armed conflict.

The Republic of Moldova, as a state which suffered the consequences of Chernobyl nuclear catastrophe, is deeply convinced that in view of the health and environmental effects the use of nuclear weapons by a state in War or other armed conflict would be a breach of its obligations under international law including the WHO's Constitution.
